

## **Breaking News- TeamKakata makes Big Initial Donation**

### **To C. H. Rennie Memorial Hospital in Kakata**

TeamKakata Association has made big donations to the C. H. Rennie Hospital in Kakata, Margibi County. Making the pronouncement from his home in Chicago, Illinois Mr. Gaye Sleh Chairman of the TeamKakata Association C. H. Rennie Hospital Emergency Relief Committee stated that his Committee just completed the short goals with the presentation of several medical Supplies and equipment including Non- Contact Thermometers, Pulse Oximeters- Finger Model, Gloves, BP Cuff, Aneroid & Manuel, Stethoscope, Hand Sanitizers with different level of Acholic, Resuscitator,(see complete list). TeamKakata also delivered one Heavy Duty Washer and One Industrial Dryer for hospital linings cleaning.

It can be record that TeamKakata Association appointed an Emergency C.H. Rennie Committee through its President Yassah Kortu- Dennis. That Committee was to immediately jump to the aid of the hospital after a disastrous fire gutted the hospital destroying its infrastructure, medical supplies, and equipment. The Committee headed by Hon. Gaye Sleh got into full swing by assessing the need of the Hospital and coming out with three-part plans, Short, Medium, and Long terms.

The Committee achieved its short-term goal with funds provided by Teamkakata Association about USD 3,000.00. Making the Presentation to the C. H. Rennie Hospital Administrator and the City of Kakata Local Officials, TKA Liaison Ms. Weemor Holmes spoke on behalf of TeamKakata President and expressed the Association membership's willingness to do more for the hospital. She further stated that the presentation was the first of a three-part plan developed by the TeamKakata C. H. Rennie Emergency Committee. The Major of the City of Kakata Hon. Emmanuel Goll and the Hospital Chief Medical received the items on behalf of the Ministry of Health and the people of Kakata. In separate remarks, the two officials of the Local Government expressed thanks and appreciation to TKA for the donations and promised to use them for the good of the people of Kakata and its environs.

In a statement released to TKA Web News Hon. Gaye Sleh expressed joy that TKA through its Emergency Relief Committee could identify with C. H. Rennie Hospital that quickly. He said that presentation was the completion of the Shot-Term Goal of TeamKakata Association and plans are now being developed to work on the Medium-Term Goals of TKA.
